



2011-12 ARC ADULT REGISTRATION

Howdy and welcome to the Alliance Rugby Club (ARC). Our adult calendar overview is:

Sep: Sunday touch games begin-**all ages welcome; 1st** friendly match

Oct: Cowtown tournament

Oct-Apr: Continue 15's matches (usually 1-2/month)

May: Begin practicing for 7's

Jun-Jul: 7's matches/tournaments

Aug: **NO RUGBY**

Overview

Note: all of the following forms will need to be turned into your team's administrator.

There are 2 forms and 1 copy we will need for each new player:

-USA Rugby CIPP registration form (select print when you register online with USA Rugby; if you forget you can print a copy from the ARC web site [USA Rugby Adult Waiver Form](#))

-ARC Adult Waiver (print from the ARC online registration or from the ARC web site [ARC Adult Waiver Form](#))

-Copy of your health insurance card

Dues are as follows:

-\$125

--1/2 Dues for ARC high school alumni for the first 4 years after graduation (includes up to 2007 graduates for this season): \$60

Mid/late Season Registrations: No matter what point in the season you join us, you are always welcome. For late joining players, dues are prorated for joining after 1 Feb to 75% of the full season dues (\$90; \$45 for 4 year alumni).



Note: new players will also need to purchase their kit (ARC shorts & socks) for \$25

USA Rugby CIPP Registration Form

CIPP stands for “Club & Individual Participation Program” and is a requirement prior to a player participating in practice or matches. It not only registers the player with USA Rugby but it provides liability coverage for all participants. For a step-by-step process on how to “Self CIPP”, see [How to CIPP Register with USA Rugby](#). Don't forget to print off a hard copy and turn it in to your team administrator.

*Note: there is a \$70 fee for registration **NEW FOR 2011-12**: includes medical coverage during sanctioned rugby activities (practice, matches, travel to and from).*

ARC Online Registration

1. Go to the Alliance Rugby Club Sports Manager site at: <http://www.sportsmanager.us/alliancerugby.htm>.
2. On the far left hand vertical column, select “Registration”
3. Under “Season”, select the “Adult Rugby 2011-2012”
4. Select either “returning parent/player” or “New to Alliance Rugby” and then follow through the instructions

Note: during the registration process, when it asks for the “Membership #”, it is asking for the CIPP registration # and the “Membership Exp” is the CIPP expiration date which is the next August.

ARC Adult Waiver

This form is located under the “Forms” link on the ARC web site home page and is titled [ARC Adult Waiver Form](#) and will need to be filled out and signed prior to a player participating in practice or matches.

Dues

Dues cover the cost of club registration with USA Rugby, field rental, ref pay, tournament fees and equipment cost. Players are required to purchase their own kit (shorts and socks) from the club at cost (\$25). For returning players with last year's kit, there is no requirement to purchase new kit this season.

Payment is paid by credit card when registering with the club's online registration.

Equipment

Players will need kit (ARC shorts & socks; \$20 for shorts, \$5 for socks; contact your side administrator to get your kit), cleats (soccer or rugby work fine) and a mouth guard.
